

Auditory Processing Domain (Illustrative Test Items)

Auditory Discrimination

I am going to say two words. If I say the same word twice, you would tell me that they are the same. If I say two different words, then you would tell me that they are different.

Sample: Say, "Listen Carefully."

Auditory Digit Memory

Sample: Say, "I am going to say some numbers and when I am finished, I want you to repeat them right after me, just as I said them. Listen carefully." Repeat the numbers one per second.

Sample: Say, "I am going to read a sentence to you. When I am finished I want you to say it just like I did. Ready? Listen carefully."






The Phelps Kindergarten Readiness Scale

The Phelps Kindergarten Readiness Scale is a remarkably affordable, easy to administer, and effective tool designed to quickly reveal the fundamental strengths and weaknesses that research has shown can make a major difference in a child's later academic career. Unlike skills-based inventories, the PKRS will not measure how much a child already has learned, instead it will open a window into his or her basic abilities — abilities that often are overlooked until it is too late to do much about them.

Research has shown that if children have difficulties with verbal, auditory, or perceptual processing at the start of their school careers, unless they are identified and remedied early, these deficits are likely to have a negative impact throughout their entire school careers. For example, we have all heard of cases where visual problems were not diagnosed early in a child's school career, simply because the child assumed that his vision was like everyone else's and never realized that a problem existed. The PKRS will provide an early indication that a child is experiencing moderate or severe difficulties and it will suggest appropriate remediation strategies, which may include more focused diagnostic testing.

The test will also point out those verbal, auditory, and perceptual areas in where a child shows special strengths. Teachers can then build on and leverage these strengths to promote greater academic achievement.

It is recommended that the PKRS be administered to all incoming kindergarten students, rather than only a select few. Since the test is capable of distinguishing between moderate as well as more severe divergences from national norms and provides suggested remediation activities, educators (often in concert with parents) can often initiate appropriate interventions months before the child actually starts school.

The PKRS is designed to be administered from the spring before a child enters kindergarten until the following fall. It may be administered by a variety of educational personnel and special instructions are included with the Manual for teachers and paraprofessionals. These instructions include a commentary on the differences between teaching and testing and provide simplified scoring protocols that do not require extensive statistical knowledge or training. The time required for actual test administration is usually less than 15 minutes per child.

The PKRS is available only to schools and school districts. Orders for copies of the PKRS are typically shipped via UPS or USPS within two days of receipt. The PKRS is currently available for English- and Spanish-speaking students.

To preserve test security, schools and districts using the test must agree to maintain strict control over copies of the test. Individuals and schools without formal kindergarten programs are not allowed to obtain copies of the test protocols.
